Please remember that during the school day teachers are delivering lessons and therefore may not see messages on Tapestry or Dojo – please continue to phone the school office with any important or urgent messages.

May I remind you that our **Parent's Evening is on Monday 15th November**, I look forward to seeing you and sharing in your children's learning journey. Our FLC's will be available to meet you informally to discuss any issues, all meetings with the teachers will take place in the classrooms. We would like to inform you that due to restrictions we will be unable to offer a crèche for our parent's evenings.

I know we have a really exciting term planned for the children – our fiction creative week will start the week beginning 11th October with a "Fantasy" theme and our classroom based Harvest celebrations will take place 20th- 22nd Oct just before we finish for ½ term.

Covid Procedures

- Our school setting will no longer be in “bubbles” but we will continue to reduce contact between large groups of children.
- We will continue to follow our hygiene procedures; all staff and children will follow these routines throughout the day.
- Lunches will be eaten in the hall, a few classes will continue eating in their classroom. Packed lunches can now be brought to school in lunch boxes.
- Children will enter and leave school through different doors/ gates and exits to reduce groups and ease crowding.
- Life skills have restarted through clear links to the children’s learning and development. Forest school and outdoor learning opportunities have been increased to support emotional wellbeing and self-regulation.



We want to ask all of our parents and carers to continue to be vigilant of Covid-19 symptoms and notify us immediately if your child or anyone in the family is unwell. Children **must not** come into school if they have symptoms and we would ask you to consider if they are unwell that they remain at home. We are unable to give paracetamol or pain relief in school unless it has been prescribed by a doctor for an ongoing condition. If you are unsure please ring school to discuss.

- We would like to make you aware that if we have high levels of staff absence in a class we may have to take the decision to close the class – this will be as a last resort due to health and safety/ safeguarding measures and we will aim to keep this time to minimum.
